*Skin Cancer often occurs due to over exposure to sunlight or getting sunburnt. There are different types of skin cancer.* 

Below are possible signs of Skin cancer. Please contact your GP if you have a skin mark / mole that has:

- changed in size
- irregular shape
- *irregular / uneven border*
- irregular colour (has different colours within it)
- largest diameter 6 mm or more
- inflammation crusts / bleeding/non-healing
- oozing
- change in sensation (feels different tingles / itches).
- Dark coloured stripe under the nail

If you notice anything unusual on your skin that does not go away after 4 weeks, show it to your doctor. It might help to take a photograph of anything unusual so you can check for any changes.
